
Learn the Creative Pedagogical Approaches to teach Project Management

Introduction



Project Management is becoming an important field of study. In recent years, it has been drawing attention from various quarters including government and across industry sectors. Project Management is largely practice driven, however over the years it has evolved beyond the concepts of planning & scheduling (CPM & PERT) to now an integrated approach drawing knowledge from different management functions. Time & cost management has largely been the focus till recently. However, other aspects of projects such as Risk Management, Stakeholder Management, Project Execution, Monitoring & Control etc. are being recognised as important for the successof any project.



There are a host of topics that need to be delivered to the students/professionals in the field such as Project Feasibility studies, Scope Management, Cost Management, Time Management, Quality Management, Human Resource Management, Materials Management, Project controls, Value Engineering, Contracts Management, Project Risk Management, Communication & Stakeholder Management and the use of Project Management Software.

The challenge for faculty teaching the above topics is to make them interesting to the students and professionals attending their programs. Hence, they need to adopt innovative ways of teaching project management.



Objective of the Program

The objective of this Faculty Development Program is enable faculty to develop an understanding of the different pedagogical approaches and adopt the most suitable approach to teach different topics in project management over and above the conventional approach of lecture teaching, use of computers/software to make class room more engaging and interactive for the students. 
